- JRNL VOL 2: Rules A.IV.H.2: All Boards and Agencies will have terms of four years... Each new four-year term shall begin at the close of the Annual Conference electing those persons; quadrennial terms shall begin at the close of the Annual Conference session following the General Conference. Service of one-half term or more in filling a vacancy of other than annual term shall be considered as a full term. The terms of those elected from the Districts shall begin upon their election. Their terms shall continue until their successors are elected...Tenure on any Conference group shall be no more than two terms.
