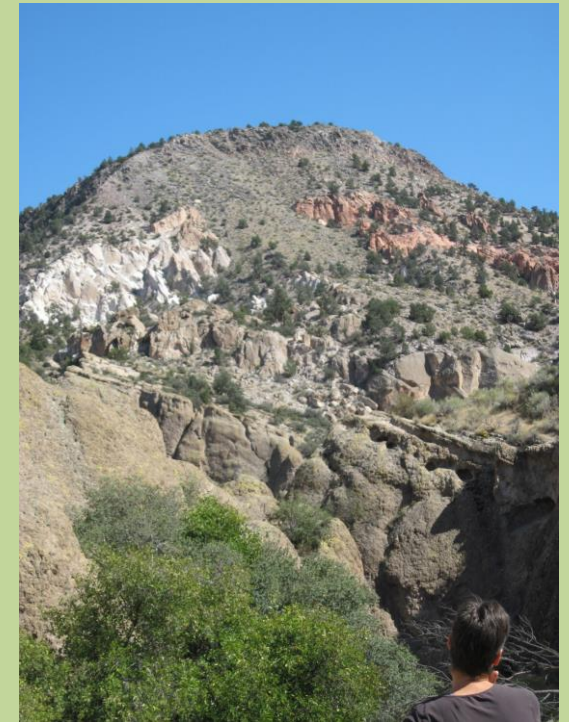

FOOD & LODGING

Tasty, wholesome food will be prepared outdoors with open fires & Dutch ovens and in church kitchen. We can cook for specific dietary needs, just notify retreat coordinator.



We have reserved a block of rooms at the Caliente Hot Springs Motel. Only 2 rooms are approved for pets. Prices range from \$75/night to \$95/night without tax. The rooms are recently renovated and guests have access to hot spring baths. Please contact the retreat coordinator by **October 1** to reserve a room. The cancellation deadline is **October 3** for full refund.



If you want to camp, we recommend Kershaw-Ryan State Park which is 2 miles south of town. The campground is first come first serve, so we recommend arriving early to reserve your campsite.
