- 2. An official transcript from the college or seminary.
- 3. *Written discernment report (BOOM 030) from the mentor.
- 4. *A brief update (i.e. one page) written by the Certified Candidate sharing current service in a congregation and demonstrating the candidate *continues* to evidence gifts, fruits and God's grace for the work of ministry.

Required Question:

• Share an example of how you have demonstrated fruitfulness in your ministry. (Example: How have you shown servant leadership? When did you start a Bible Study, lead a mission trip, served with the poor, or taught others about Christ. What is your evidence of fruitfulness?)

Suggested Additional Questions (Choose a minimum of three)

- How have you grown as a disciple of Jesus Christ?
- What are you most passionate about when it comes to your United Methodist identity?
- What were some of your frustrations in ministry this year?
- Share several highlights of your ministry this year.
- Share about your devotional life. How are you growing spiritually?
- Tell us about your personal leadership strengths...your growing edges.
- What are you doing to avoid burnout?
- What are your goals for the year ahead?
- Tell us about your understanding of the sacraments in the United Methodist Church.
- What is your understanding of the Mission of the Church?
- What have you read that has been helpful in your spiritual life?
- What did you learn about yourself in the psychological assessment process?
- What are the most stressful aspects of ministry for you?
- What do you do to take care of yourself physically?
- Share a conflict situation in which you have been involved and how you dealt with it.
- Share a leadership experience you have had this year.
- Tell us about your seminary/course of study classes (for students).
