## 1. Sapp Scholarship

- Priority given to certified candidates enrolled in seminary, application for scholarship is posted on https://dscumc.org/board-of-ordained-ministry/funding/
- b. Eligible to current appointed clergy and local pastors
- c. Applications are accepted through March 1.

## 2. Scott Clergy Crisis Fund

- a. Eligibility is for clergy families in need due to crisis.
- b. Requests are set at \$1000 minimum.
- c. Applications are considered on a rolling basis.

## 3. **Botkin Medical Grant (as of 2020, this fund has \$153,000)**

- a. Assisting active or retired Methodist Ministers and their families who may be faced with unusual and burdensome medical expenses. Can include other emergency needs such as psychological and dental expenses/needs, including transportation to and from appointments for medical, dental, psychological.
- b. Applications are considered on a rolling basis.
