SCHOLARSHIP AND FINANCIAL AID POLICIES

- 1. The Board of Ordained Ministry, through its Scholarship and Grant Committee Chair, shall be the administrator of funds designated for scholarships and financial aid.
- 2. Persons who are certified candidates by their District Committee on Ordained Ministry in the Desert Southwest Annual Conference and seeking ordination or commissioning shall be eligible to receive aid. Persons seeking loan forgiveness will need to be recognized as provisional or associate members by the Board of Ordained Ministry.
- 3. The following types of financial aid may be granted as funds permit:
 - a) Aid for books and supplies
 - b) Tuition aid on the basis of need as determined by the Board of Ordained Ministry. Maximum grants per calendar year shall not exceed \$4,000 for full-time candidates for ordained ministry. This will be paid at the rate of \$160 per credit hour per semester or quarter.
 - c) Emergency living expenses on the basis of need as determined by Board of Ordained Ministry.
 - d) All forms of help from the Desert Southwest Conference will not exceed \$12,000 per student for all seminary years.
- 4. The Board of Ordained Ministry requires that all requests be made in writing on a form provided by the Scholarship and Grant Committee Chair for the Board of Ordained Ministry.
- 5. The Board of Ordained Ministry shall approve this request prior to any financial commitments being made. No discretion to make such commitment is given to any member of the Board of Ordained Ministry. The Executive Committee of the Board may approve requests between regular meetings of the full Board of Ordained Ministry.
- 6. For those seeking ordination, all such aid will be regarded as an interest free loan until such recipient has completed three (3) years of full time service under a District Superintendent in the Desert Southwest Annual Conference AND recipient has achieved provisional or associate member status, at which time the aid becomes a grant. If one does not complete the three (3) years, the loan becomes payable at a rate equal tothe national prime rate (the prime rate that is effective at time of converting this agreement into a loan plus I%.) A payback schedule will be worked out between the Board of Ordained Ministry and the person who has incurred the loan. A candidate receiving multiple requests for funding shall have years of service compounded with a maximum of six (6) years of service under appointment in the Desert Southwest Annual Conference to fulfill the covenant.
- 7. Financial aid shall be sent directly to the educational institution on behalf of the recipient, unless otherwise instructed by the Board of Ordained Ministry.
- 8. Evidence of financial aid is a requirement.
