### **Segment 2 Guide on C<sup>3</sup>**

The S/PPRC Segment 2 video on the three important Cs of Connection, Conflict, and Confidentiality may be viewed during an S/PPRC meeting, or you may choose to provide the link to the S/PPRC members and ask them to view the video before a meeting. The following are some points for your S/PPRC to discuss after or during viewing.

- A Connections Conversation.
  - What do you understand to be the main purpose and function of SPRC as a connecting point?
  - Identify ways your SPRC has assisted in linking the pastor and staff with the congregation.
  - Discuss the role of Liaison/Advocate with staff members. Helpful and effective ways as well as unsuitable roles?
  - Discuss the guidelines or expectations of behavior of your SPRC members as you connect to the pastor, the congregation, the district superintendent, and people experiencing a call to ministry.
- On Conflict.
  - How do you often respond to conflict? Freeze, Flight, or Fight?
  - Review a recent conflict situation your SPRC has needed to manage. Identify effective and ineffective ways the conflict was responded to.
  - Respond to the Pyramid Path of Five. Perhaps have your own role play on a familiar situation.
- Confidentiality.
  - Review what this means to your S/PPRC.
  - Name some recent topics of SPRC conversation which you identify as needing confidentiality.
  - What is the result or consequence of breaking confidentiality?
