The Marilyn Jean Chapman Scholarship was established by the United Methodist Women, now known as United Women in Faith, of the Desert Southwest Conference in loving memory of the Marilyn Jean

Chapman. Marilyn served United Methodist Women, now known as United Women in Faith, in many areas throughout the years. She was Dean of the School of Christian Mission for four years, 1986-1990.

The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage awareness and understanding of United Women in Faith through education and participation in School of Christian Mission, now known as MISSION u.

The scholarship will cover the registration and housing, according to the Conference Standing Rules, to MISSION u. The cost of transportation and study materials will be the responsibility of the recipient of the scholarship.

Persons applying for the scholarship must be first time attendees to MISSION u and be willing to report back to her local unit and/or church

Annual recipients of this scholarship are asked to write a brief article about her MISSION u experience, and submit it to the District Communication Coordinator by August 15 following MISSION u. She is expected to attend the District Annual Celebration held in the fall of the year.
