MARILYN JEAN CHAPMAN SCHOLARSHIP

The Marilyn Jean Chapman Scholarship was established by the United Methodist Women, now known as United Women in Faith, of the Desert Southwest Conference in loving memory of the Marilyn Jean Chapman. Marilyn served United Methodist Women, now known as United Women in Faith, in many areas throughout the years. She was Dean of the School of Christian Mission for four years, 1986-1990.

The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage awareness and understanding of United Women in Faith through education and participation in School of Christian Mission, now known as MISSION u.

The scholarship will cover the registration and housing, according to the Conference Standing Rules, to MISSION u. The cost of transportation and study materials will be the responsibility of the recipient of the scholarship.

Persons applying for the scholarship must be first time attendees to MISSION u and be willing to report back to her local unit and/or church

Annual recipients of this scholarship are asked to write a brief article about her MISSION u experience, and submit it to the District Communication Coordinator by August 15 following MISSION u. She is expected to attend the District Annual Celebration held in the fall of the year.

Two scholarships will be given in each District. Scholarship applications must be submitted to the District President no later than **May 15** for the MISSION u that year. Applicants will be notified by June 15, prior to MISSION u, of their selection / rejection regarding the scholarship.

Funding for the Scholarship comes from the established Marilyn Jean Chapman Scholarship Fund and is increased and grown by gifts from individuals, as well as Local and District units.
