MARILYN SUE STOUT SCHOLARSHIP

The Marilyn Sue Stout Scholarship was established to encourage and educate teenage and young adult women in the Desert Southwest Conference of the United Methodist Church, as a means to gain an awareness, understanding, and involvement in the lay organization of United Methodist Women, now known as United Women in Faith.

The Scholarship will cover the registration, lodging, books and travel, for MISSION u (previously known as School of Christian Mission).

Applicants for the Marilyn Sue Stout Scholarship must be ages 14 to 30 at the time that MISSION u begins

Applicants must be attending MISSION u for the first time. The recipient of the Scholarship shall attend and participate in all sessions of MISSION u. All youth (under 18 years) shall be chaperoned by and room with an adult. The chaperon is responsible for her personal registration, room, and fees at MISSION u.

Applications for the Marilyn Sue Stout Scholarship must be submitted to the District United Women in Faith President no later than **May 15** for MISSION u that year. Recipient of the scholarship will be notified by June 15, preceding MISSION u.

The Scholarship recipient is expected to report back to her local United Women in Faith and/or church in an appropriate manner. She is also asked to write a brief article about her MISSION u experience and submit it to the District Communication Coordinator by August 15 following MISSION u and shall attend the Annual District Celebration.
