These directors hold classes to help persons who wish to be certified as Lay Servants, Lay Speakers, and Lay Ministers. To become a Certified Lay Servant, one must take the Basic Course and one Advanced Course. They can go on and become a Certified Lay Speaker by taking the required six classes. To become a Certified Lay Minister, one must be a Certified Lay Servant and finish four learning modules and be approved by their District Committee Ordained Ministers (DCOM) with final approval coming from the Conference Director Lay Servant Ministries.
