

Fire Relief Buckets (Approximate cost \$60)

Note: Fire Resource Buckets are especially needed in the Western Jurisdiction as other Jurisdictions do not solicit or stock them (or Ash Sifters)

- 1 5-Gallon bucket with re-sealable lid - Buckets from fast-food restaurants or bakeries can be used if washed and cleaned -Do not use buckets that have stored chemicals such as paint or pool cleaner. Advertisements on the outside are acceptable
- Tyvek coveralls—XL or XXL (can tape them up for smaller bodies)
- 5 N95 dust masks (or similar if not available)
- 2 pair work gloves
- 8 pair Nitrile gloves to wear under work gloves
- 1 pack of at least 28 disinfecting wipes or multi-purpose cleaning wipes
- 1 box cutter
- 1 roll duct tape
- 2 Soot sponges (advertised to use for cleaning fireplaces)
- 6 Heavy duty construction trash bags (33-45 gallon)
- 1 Hand hoe
- 1 Hand trowel

Additional supplies not in Fire Resource buckets, but donations are also useful of: Square nosed shovels and rakes
