Thanks goes to Gerri Eason, Cheryl Williams, Stephanie McKoy, Jasmine Griffin, Irene Harrison, along with Eileen Guillermo of Journey UMC who acted as our photographer, for being helping hands in seeing a dream fulfilled. These members of Zion's UWF, stayed after service and spent a few hours sorting the items into individual bags Our collective efforts managed to fill 30 bags (containing an eclectic assortment of items ranging from hygiene, diapers, socks, calendars, pens and prayer books) to be donated to the Olive Crest Organization. CPL Lena King is also the recipient of the Congressional Gold Medal as her Battalion the 6888th was honored with this award in March 2022 for their distinguished achievements and contributions overseas during World War II. The women of that battalion moved 640,000 pieces of mail per shift, 3 shifts per day.

Lena King is a long- time member of Desert Spring Church and United Women in Faith, although she still refers to our group UMW! Lena is not only a WW2 veteran but an all around awesome lady.
